#### Remembrance Day in School

Gordon Primary School are celebrating Remembrance Day on Friday 10th November.

P7s will have their annual service of Remembrance at the memorial from 10.50am. Poetry will be read and a 2 minute silence will happen at 11am. Carol Ford, minister of Strathboaie Drumblade Church will be in attendance.

Parents and families are welcome to attend. The children stand on the semicircle and at the foot of the monument but there is plenty of room. A poppy wreath will also be laid. Please be aware that traffic is not stopped so please be mindful if you have small children with you.

In school, P7s have read poems to the children in assemblies, poppy displays around and the children will observe a one minute silence at 11am.

P7 Remembrance poem readers will also attend Alexander Scott's Hospital Eventide Home on Monday afternoon to read poems to the old folks.

Poppies are also on sale this week. P7s will come around the classes to sell poppies each day. Please give what you are happy to give. The money goes toward supporting soldiers who have served for us in war keeping us safe and who require support in some way.



#### Winter

The nights are definitely drawing in... therefore, please ensure your children have reflective garments, bands, badges etc so drivers can see them. Please remind them to walk safely on pavements and use appropriate places to cross.

Children also need to be wrapped up warmly for playing outside but be able to remove layers if warm in school. Indoor shoes are essential at this time of vear and whilst slippers are fine for the classroom, gymshoes or trainers are required for PE. Should you have difficulty purchasing any of these items please aet in touch in confidence and we will try to help out without causing embarrassment.
